REQUIRED Coursework for UHP

ELECTIVE courses for UHP (must take at least 2 HONR 3700 classes)

Important notes:

- *LBST 11xx-H may be taken either fall or spring of first year*
- *LBST 2301-H may be taken either fall or spring of second year*
- *All other LBST-H classes may be taken 3rd, 4th, 5th, or 6th semester*
- *HONR 3700 may be taken 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th semester (minimum of two HONR 3700 are required)*
- *A study abroad trip approved by the Honors College may count as one HONR 3700*
- *All honors coursework should be completed before starting the HONR 3790/3791 sequence*
